Peggy Snoddy Smith Robinson, 94, wife of the late Donald Stewart Robinson, Sr., passed away July 19, 2024.

A native of Spartanburg County, daughter of the late James Rogers Snoddy and Eulalie Lawrence Snoddy, she attended Furman University, graduated from Converse College, and was a retired teacher in Spartanburg County District Five Schools. She was a member of the Society of First Families of South Carolina, John Boswell Chapter of The National Society of Colonial Dames XVII Century, The Huguenot Society of South Carolina, Joyce Scott Chapter of Daughters of The American Revolution, South Carolina, Genealogical Society, Spartanburg Historical Society, and charter member of the Cema Chreitzberg Garden Club of Spartanburg for 66 years. Mrs. Robinson was a member of Nazareth Presbyterian Church, Moore, South Carolina.
