



## Dr. Quentin Wade Thomas

December 12, 1964 - December 14, 2024

Dr. Quentin Wade Thomas, age 60, passed away at home on December 14, 2024.

A native of Pittsburgh PA, he was son to Lee Gilchrist Thomas and the late Gretchen Miller Thomas.

After graduating High School in 1982, Quentin proudly served in the U.S. Army as a specialist (E-4) with the 2nd Infantry Division 2nd Military Police company and was honorably discharged after receiving several medals.

Also surviving are his wife Christine Veith Thomas of Greer, a son, Quentin Lee Thomas of Pittsburgh PA, four grandchildren; a brother Lex Thomas; two sisters, Dorinda Bauer and Lucinda Thomas of Pennsylvania; and several nieces and nephews.

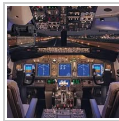
