Racheal Lollis Sammons, 90, of Taylors, SC, reached her long-desired heavenly home to be with her Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, on June 1, 2017, following an extended illness.

She was predeceased by her husband of 64 years, Thaddeus Edward Sammons Jr., the love of her life; her parents, Ben Guy and Nancy (Sweetie) Lollis, four brothers, and one sister.

She spent most of her life in support of her husband's avid evangelistic outreach and extended it beyond his lifetime by being available to talk with friends and strangers about the Lord as opportunities arose. Though limited by physical infirmities in her later years, she used the telephone as a vehicle for listening to others in need and giving spiritual encouragement, reminding them of the grace and provision of God.

Mrs. Sammons possessed an eye for detail which she used to create beauty in her yard and home. She had a big personality marked by a lively sense of humor, fun, and a certain feistiness. She enjoyed making people laugh with her, often through colorful stories from her youth. She had a tender heart, especially for her family, but also for those who did not know the Lord, for children and others in spiritual social or material need.

Mrs. Sammons is survived by her three children: David Sammons, Sr. of Taylors, Guy Sammons (Sandra) of Savannah, GA, and Gena Mistretta (Pete) also of Taylors, who were her primary caregivers several years; three grandchildren and six great-grandchildren.

Mrs. Sammons was a member of Milford Baptist Church of Greer, SC. Funeral services will be held Monday, June 5, 2017, at 1 P.M. at Mountain Creek Baptist Church, 255 W. Mountain Creek Road of Greenville, SC with Dr. Dusty Reynolds of Savannah, GA, officiating. Visitation will be from 11:30 A.M. to 12:45 P.M. preceding the service at church.
