Ralph Aaron Lynn, 88, of 102 Circle Drive, died July 30, 2009 at his home. A native of Greer, son of the late James Arthur and Merzie Brown Lynn, he was a U.S. Army veteran of WWII, a retired employee of Greer Middle School, where he was known as “Mr. Tea Man”, and a retired employee of M. Lowenstein. He was a member of Greer First Baptist Church, where he was a member of the Baraca Sunday School Class and a charter member of the Barnabas Factor.
