Reba Ann Southerlin Wells, 85, wife of the late John Larry Wells, Sr., passed away January 31, 2024.

A native of Greenville County, daughter of the late William B. and Nancy Hightower Southerlin, she made history by graduating with 3 degrees from North Greenville University and was 55 years old when she finished her last degree with a Bachelor of Arts in Christian Studies. She was a retired employee of North Greenville University and Lookup Lodge, and was a member of Tigerville Baptist Church, where she played the piano and organ. She taught piano, loved music, reading, and crossword puzzles.
