Rev. George Wilson Bryans, Sr., 87, of 10682-B Greenville Highway, widower of Lillie Mae Padgett Bryans, died May 16, 2006 at Spartanburg Regional Hospital.

A native of Kannapolis, North Carolina, son of the late Albert Henry and Estelle Moore Bryans, he served in the U.S. Army 3rd Battalion 413th Infantry Regiment during WWII as a machine gunner in Germany. Rev. Bryans was an ordained retired Wesleyan minister having served 29 years in the following churches: Rock Bridge and Buck Creek Wesleyan Churches in North Carolina, Eden Wesleyan Church in Cooley Springs, Sumter Wesleyan Church in Sumter, SC, Iva Wesleyan Church in Iva, SC, Glenville Wesleyan Church in Glenville, NC, and Tuckasegee Wesleyan Church in Tuckasegee, NC. Rev. Bryans was a member of Glenville Wesleyan Church, Glenville, NC. He was retired chaplain for the rescue squad in Glenville, NC and a retired custodian for the Jackson County Schools.

Surviving are a son and daughter-in-law, George Wilson Bryans, Jr. and Mary Bryans of Lyman; a daughter and son-in-law, Gloria Ann and James W. Hawkins of Wellford; five grandchildren and eight great-grandchildren; and an adopted sister, Betty Autry of Gainesville, Georgia.

Funeral services will be held 3:00 p.m. Thursday at Lyman Wesleyan Church, conducted by Rev. Randy Rush and Rev. Archie Hobbs. Burial will follow in

Wood Memorial Park.

Grandsons and great-grandsons will serve as pallbearers.
