



## Rev. Hall Marion Hollifield

July 7, 1919 - April 13, 2012

Rev. Hall Marion Hollifield, 92, of 106 Chestnut Ave. died April 13, 2012 at Greer Memorial Hospital. He was the widower of Ruth Beatrice Davis Hollifield.

A native of Ila, Georgia, born July 7, 1919, he was a son of the late Harve and Flora Culberson Hollifield. He was a graduate of North Greenville (College) University, Fruitland Bible College and Southeastern Seminary. He was a minister and was a former pastor of Fairmont Baptist Church, Fairmont, SC, First Baptist Church of Nebo, Nebo, NC, and Second Baptist Church, Greer. After his retirement, he served as interim of several churches. He was recently recognized as Pastor Emeritus of First Baptist Church of Nebo, NC.
