Rev. Jake Ballenger Marshbanks, 72, of 2010 East Lee Road, died February 7, 2008.

A native of Anderson County, son of the late Herman Ballenger and Martha Leedell Moody Marshbanks, he received an associates degree in theology from Fruitland Bible College and was a retired minister from First Baptist Church in Wooten, Kentucky. Rev. Marshbanks was a member of Lee Road Baptist Church, where he was a member of the Joy Club and the Adult Choir. Rev. Marshbanks was a U.S. Army and Air Force veteran, a dispatcher with the S.C. Highway Patrol, and a State Constable. He was a former volunteer fireman with the Wade Hampton Fire Department.

Surviving are his wife, Gail Bryant Marshbanks of the home; two sons and daughter-in-law, Jeffrey Marshbanks of Waterloo and John and Kristin Marshbanks of Taylors; two daughters and sons-in-law, Linda and Jerry Cely of Taylors and Brenda and George Carter of Greer; a brother and sister-in-law, Ralph and Lucille Marshbanks of Jacksonville, N.C.; a sister, Pat M.
