Rev. Silas Samuel Wright, 65, of 126 Martin Street, died November 14, 2007 at his home.

Rev. Wright was a son of the late William Albert and Ellen Gordon Wright. He received a B.S. degree in Theology, was the former pastor of Faith Holiness Church in Greer for eight years, former pastor of First Pentecostal Holiness Church in Newton, North Carolina for six years, and was a state evangelist for the Pentecostal Holiness in Western North Carolina for nine years. Rev.

Wright served as president of his voting precinct, was a delegate for the 2004 Republican National Convention, and went to five different countries on mission trips. He was a member of Lighthouse Pentecostal Holiness Church of Kings Mountain, North Carolina.

Surviving are his wife, Shirley Guy Wright of the home; a daughter, Angel W. Smith of Johnson City, Tennessee; two sons, William C. Wright of Greer and Samuel Wayne Wright of Startex; three brothers, Paul Wright, Saul Wright, and Job Wright all of Pacolet; a sister, Sarah Coggins of Cowpens; and six grandchildren, Addison Wright, Caleb Wright, Isaac Smith, Alex Wright, Faith Smith, and Andrew Wright.

Funeral services will be held 1:00 p.m. Saturday at Fairforest Church of God, conducted by Rev. Darrell Alexander, Bishop Thomas H. McGhee, and Rev. John Petty. Burial will follow in Wood Memorial Park.

Visitation will be held 6:30-8:30 p.m. Friday at the Wood Mortuary.
