Robert A. (Bob) Bailey, 85, died June 27, 2010 at Greenville Memorial Hospital.

A native of New Castle, Pennsylvania, son of the late Joseph A. and Clara Mooney Bailey, he was a U.S. Army veteran of WWII, graduated Magna Cum Laude from Bob Jones University and was a retired building contractor. Mr. Bailey was a member of Second Presbyterian Church, Greenville and The Gideons.

Surviving are his wife, Lee McClendon Bailey of the home; four daughters, Sheri (Jim) Elwood, Vivienne (Mark) Harris, Deyna (Phillip) Dodd, and Rosanne (Clark) Walters; two brothers, John Bailey and Donald Bailey; a sister, Sylvia Greenway; six grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.
