Robert Samuel Gaddis, 82, of 475 East Mountain Creek Road, died July 5, 2008 at his home.

A native of Greenwood County, son of the late John D. (Jake) and Mamie Reeves Gaddis, he was a graduate of Taylors High School and Clemson University where he received a degree in architectural engineering. Mr. Gaddis played baseball with the Greenville American Legion, the Southern Textile League, and Clemson University. He was a U.S. Navy veteran of WWII, a Boy Scout leader, a retired employee of J.E. Serrine, and of the Methodist faith.

Surviving are his wife, Margaret Roberts Gaddis of the home; a daughter, Elaine Gaddis Neff of Charleston; two sons, Michael Gaddis and Grayson Gaddis both of Taylors; and three grandchildren, Ryan Clark Neff, Ellen Elaine Neff, and Margaret Nicole Gaddis.
