Robert “Bob” Lee Newhart, Sr., 90, entered his heavenly home on January 15, 2022.

A native of Ewington, Ohio, son of the late Clyde and Nora Irene Bondham Newhart, he served in the United States Air force for 21 years during both the Korean and Vietnam Wars before retiring in 1972. During his military career Bob served in numerous locations in the United States, Europe, and Southeast Asia. He was a member of Double Springs Baptist Church; a member of the Chapin Lions Club for 12 years and was honored as Lion of the Year in 2010. Bob was a member of the American Legion for 30 years and recognized for his community service in 2007.
