August 26, 1940 - January 22, 2015

Robert Lowry Wylie III, widower of Marguerite Volkner Wylie, passed away on January 22, 2015.

He was born on August 26, 1940 in Gastonia, NC to the late Robert Lowry Wylie, Jr. and Isabel Allen Wylie. He was a 1962 graduate of Presbyterian College in Clinton, SC and University of South Carolina School of Law in 1968. He served as an officer in the U.S. Army, stationed in Schofield Barracks, Hawaii and in the Army Reserves.

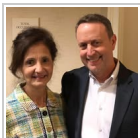
