Robin "Rob" David Deneke, 56, of 219 Cornelson Drive, died unexpectedly November 8, 2013 at Greenville Memorial Hospital.

A native of Wayne County, Ohio, son of the late Robert Wallace and Vita Hartzler Deneke, he was an employee of Litco International and a member of Redeemer Lutheran Church. Rob graduated from Smithville High School in Ohio, class of 1975, where he was an active athlete in most sports. He continued to be an active softball player throughout his adulthood. Once he had children he coached softball and soccer then supported his passion of sports through Blue Ridge Athletics in South Carolina.

Surviving are his wife, Annette Dalessandro Deneke of the home; two daughters and son-in-law, Chelsea and Asa Kinnunen of Greer and Mary Beth Deneke of the home; a brother and sister-in-law, James and Judy Deneke of Greer; and three sisters and brother-in-law, Pat Frary and Bea Deneke both of Greer, Sue and Phillip Horst of Granville, Ohio.

A memorial service will be held 5:00 p.m. Wednesday at The Wood Mortuary, conducted by Pastor Jeff Lageman and Pastor Scottie Burkhalter.

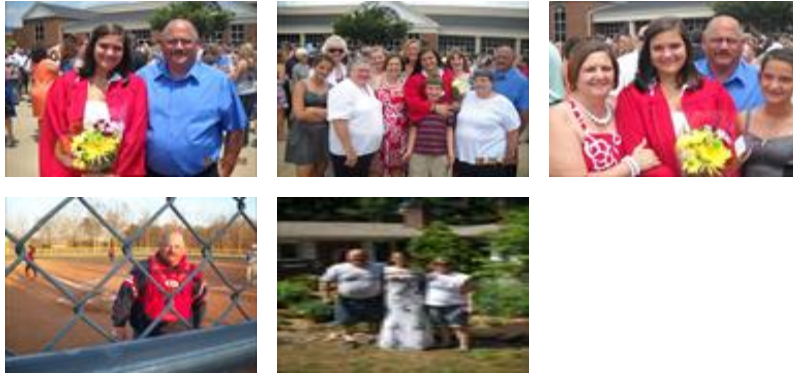
