Ronald Erwin Hall, 79, died March 24, 2014 at Greenville Memorial Hospital. A native of Atlanta, Georgia, then moved to Clyde, North Carolina at an early age, he was a son of the late John Oscar and Margaret Haynes Hall. Mr. Hall was a retired operations manager for ABF Freight Lines and a charter member of Edwards Road Baptist Church, where he was active in all phases of the church. He was a lover of all things outdoors such as backpacking, camping and fly fishing in the mountains. He and Nina have traveled to all 50 states and many foreign countries. Mr. Hall was kind, caring and always willing to help others.

Surviving are his loving wife of 60 years, Nina Medford Hall of the home; a son, John Lane Hall, M.D. and his husband, Richard Anderson of Pacifica, California; a daughter, Rhonda H. Cartee of the home; a niece, Susan Gregory of Waynesville, North Carolina; and his loving dog, Carley.
