



## Ronnie Alexander

Ronald "Ronnie" Meredith Alexander, 65, of 1396 Milford Church Road, died June 14, 2012 at Alpha Health and Rehab.

A native of Greenville County, son of the late Grady Livingston and Ruth Helen Horne Alexander, he was a graduate of Greer High School and a retired employee of Carotell Paper. Mr. Alexander was a U.S. Army Vietnam Veteran, a member of Vietnam Veterans of America #523, Greer DAV Chapter of 39, and National Order of Trench Rats Chapter 638, where he was the imperial executive Rat for the ninth district.
