Ronnie Max Hendrix, 62, died October 2, 2011 at his residence.

A native of Spartanburg County, son of the late Coy Max and Ruby Jennings Hendrix, he was a self-employed carpenter, a U.S. Army Vietnam Era Veteran and a member of Burnsvie Baptist Church.
