

## Ruth F. Davis

May 7, 1943 - November 27, 2025

Ruth Finch Davis, 82, widow of Marvin Eugene Davis, passed away November 27, 2025.

A native of Fletcher, North Carolina, she was a daughter of the late Floyd W. Finch, Sr. and Ruth Mallory Finch.

Ruth graduated Valedictorian from Valley Springs High School in 1961. She graduated Magna Cum Laude from Western Carolina College in 1965 with a B.S. in Education and taught high school biology for 10 years. She graduated Summa Cum Laude from Western Carolina University in 1977 with a B.S. in Medical Technology. She was elected to Who's Who Among Students in American Universities and Colleges in 1964-65 and 1976-77. She worked at Pardee Hospital as a bench tech and then as Lab Manager from 1977 until 1992. Ruth and Gene moved to Greer and she taught the Medical Tech Program at Spartanburg Community College from 1992 until her retirement in 2012.

Surviving are two stepsons, Terry E. Davis (Karen), Christopher E. Davis (Sharon) all of Easley, South Carolina; one stepdaughter, Pamela E. Morris of Liberty, South Carolina; two brothers, Morris M. 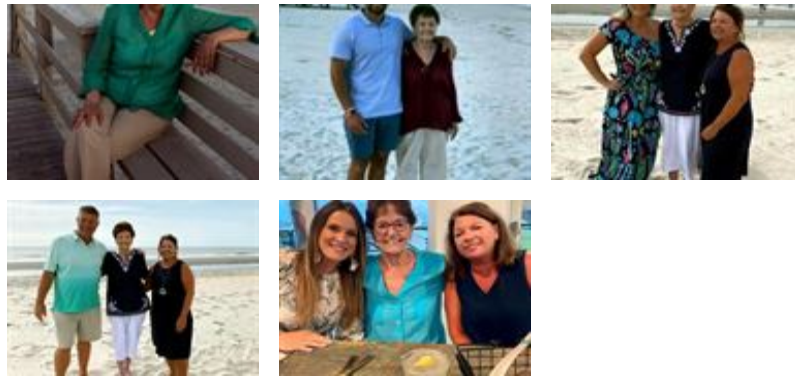
