Rev. Sam H. Hammett, 71, went home to be with the Lord December 11, 2014.

A native of Spartanburg County, son of the late Thomas Jefferson and Mattie Burris Hammett, he was predeceased by his precious wife Brenda Hammett after being married for 48 years. Sam was a retired minister and Pastor Emeritus of Grace Baptist Church after serving faithfully for 32 years. He was a U.S. Army Veteran having served 28 years in the U.S. Army Reserves. Surviving are two daughters, Lisa Mayfield and her husband, Mark Mayfield of Rock Hill and Julie Cannon and her husband, Rev. Stephen Cannon of Travelers Rest; one brother, John W.
