Sara Frances Abercrombie Wallace, 87, of 107 Laurel Road, died Saturday, August 8, 2009, at Greenville Memorial Hospital.

She was a native of Laurens, and the daughter of the late John Frank Abercrombie and Homoselle Blackmon. A 1938 graduate of Laurens High School and a 1942 graduate of Winthrop College, she continued her education with graduate studies at Furman University.

A lifetime educator, she taught high school for more than 30 years, retiring as head of the Commerce Department at Greer High School. She was a member of the Sullivan-Dunklin Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution and Memorial United Methodist Church and the Camak Sunday School Class. A former active participant of the Meals on Wheels program, she was an avid bridge player and a member of her bridge club for over 40 years.

Sara Frances was known for her humor, keen wit, and great love for family, friends and family dog, Happy.

She is survived by her husband of 62 years, Martin Gary Wallace, Jr., of Greer; three daughters, Lynne Mitchell (Dana) of Greenville; Marcia Deatcher of Greenville; Libby Wallace (Mike Keeshen) of Greenville; and a son: Martin Gary Wallace, III (Beth) of Greenville.

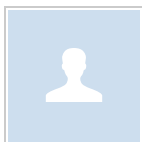
