Jonathan Scott Nix, 61, passed away December 21, 2024.

A native of Greer, South Carolina, son of Glenda Senkbeil Nix of Greer, South Carolina and the late William "Bill" Nix. He worked as a carpenter for 47 years, and was one of the youngest to achieve his builders license in the state of South Carolina. Scott was a project manager for STI and was an avid outdoorsman, enjoyed hunting, fishing, Bluegrass Music, and Jeeps.
