Barry Scott (Satty) Satterfield, 44, of Greenville, died September 9, 2007 at Memorial Health in Savannah, Georgia.

A native of Greenville County, son of the late Alvin J. and Patsy Holliday Satterfield, he was self-employed and attended Legacy Outreach Church in Spartanburg.
