Sidney H. Badger, Jr., 80, of Nashville, Tennessee, formerly of Taylors, died April 20, 2006 at Bethany Health Care Center, after a battle with cancer.

Born in Greenville County, he was the son of the late Sidney H. Badger, Sr. and Anzie B. Badger.

He was a 1946 graduate of Taylors High School and a 1988 graduate of the University of South Carolina. He was a United States Navy Veteran, having served during World War II.

He was a retired self-employed talent promoter in Nashville, TN. After retirement he drove a van for the Guest House Inn in Nashville, carrying patients to the Vanderbilt Hospital and Veterans Administration Hospital.

He was a member of Belmont Heights Methodist Church in Nashville, TN.

Surviving are two brothers, Hugh L. Badgers, Sr. and his wife, Robbie, of Greenville, S.C., Johnny Badger and his wife, Dawn of Taylors, S.C.; two sisters, Mary B. Gay and Jim Gay of Taylors, S.C. and Anne Robertson of Vallejo, CA.; and eleven nieces and nephews.

Graveside services will be held at Taylors First Baptist Church Cemetery on Thursday, April 27, 2006 at 11:00 a.m. Dr. Frank Page will be the officiating minister.
