April 9, 1949 - April 28, 2026

Wilson Bobo “Sonny” Tucker, 77, passed away April 28, 2026.

Son of the late Henry G. and Ruby Taylor Tucker, Sonny was a United States Army Veteran and lifelong resident of Greer. He was a man of fantastic stories, incomparable humor, vast knowledge on most every subject, craftsman skills, sage advice, and most importantly, a heart for loving others big. He brought laughter to every room, and his friends were many.

Sonny and Theresa were married in Fürth, Germany, where Sonny was stationed with the U.S. Army. They were far from home and faced logistical challenges – including Theresa’s stolen wedding dress and a marriage license written in German. But love prevailed, and the occasion marked the start of a beautiful 55-year marriage. Together they had one son, who, fortunately for all of us, carries on his dad’s humor.

Throughout his later years, he was a larger-than-life grandfather. His three grandkids were always greeted with a brain teaser or a “did you know...” fun fact that was probably true and most likely silly. They slept on his chest, took rides on his shoulders and lawnmower, rode power wheels in his driveway, made the largest dish soap bubbles you’ve ever seen, and hunted eggs in his yard. They ate his boiled peanuts and Edwards pies, drank his tea, drove his golf cart, and eventually borrowed his truck. He gifted them hicky-doods, sacks

of coins, and an occasional \$2 bill. From baby years to adulthood, Pop Pop's hero status never wavered.

Sonny took great care of his yard, his home, his boxers, his hummingbirds, his friends, and his family. If you called him (on his home phone), he'd greet you with his patented high-pitch "hello." If you needed him, he'd be there in a minute. He was an incredible example of loving your people.

Surviving are his wife, Theresa Giles Tucker of the home; a son, Wesley James Tucker (Samantha) of Greenville; a brother, Henry G. Tucker, Jr. (Brenda) of Lexington, SC; and three grandchildren, Maxwell James Tucker, Ollie Vaniman Tucker, and Maris Taylor Tucker.

A funeral service will be held 4:00 p.m., Saturday, May 2, 2026, at The Wood Mortuary Chapel conducted by Stacy Williams.
