Steinar Murray, 66, passed away February 19, 2017 at his home.

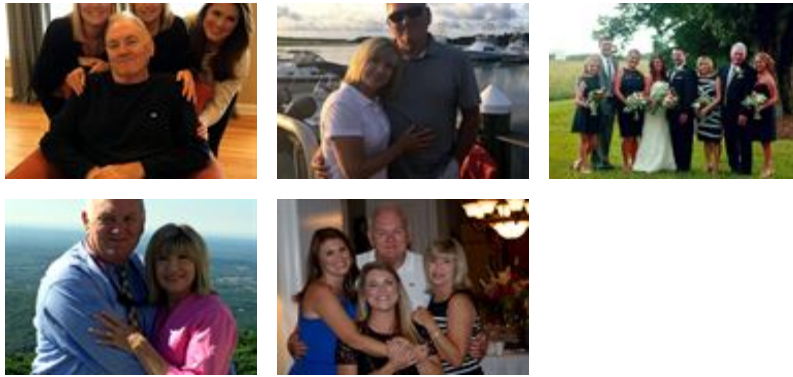
