Talmadge Douglas "Slab" Campbell, 86, passed away January 7, 2018. A native of Greenville County, son of the late George Henry and Earline Blanton Campbell, he was a U.S. Navy Veteran of the Korean War, a retired employee of Exide Battery and a member of Southside Baptist Church. He served on Greer City Council for 4 years and served on Chairman Board of Adjustment and Appeals over 20 years.
