Elteen Ted Lindsay, 84, passed away May 2, 2021.

A native of Greer, son of the late Francis Eugene and Agnes Durham “Granny” Lindsay, he was a U.S. Air Force Reserves Veteran, a retired employee of City of Greer Parks and Recreation, a former employee of Hertz Rental Car and Rolling Green Village, and a charter member of Northwood Baptist Church.

Surviving are his wife, Susan Dillard Lindsay of the home; a daughter, Lorrie Lusk (Randall) of Seneca; one sister, Bobbie Jo Hudson of Greer; and a grandson, Justin Lusk.

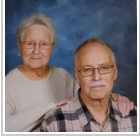
