Terri Leigh Crawford, 38, of Powdersville began her heavenly flight on Friday, July 16, 2010, as the result of a tragic automobile accident.

Terri was born on August 18, 1971 in Greenville County to Robert Howard and Shirley Dudley Crawford of Powdersville.

Terri was predeceased by her brother, Horace Edwin Crawford, II and "Belle". In addition, she was predeceased by her grandparents: Horace Crawford, Azalee Crawford Foster, Kenneth Foster, Betty and Gaither Cooke, and Martha Lorraine Thomasson.

Terri is survived in addition to her parents by her beloved "Hunter", her sister Julie C. Reilly and brother-in-law Nathan Reilly of Piedmont, her brother T. Todd Crawford and sister-in-law Tonia L. Crawford of Easley, her precious nieces and nephews whom she claimed as her "babies", Jessi L. Reilly, Drew Reilly, Sarah-Beth Crawford, Adam Crawford and her namesake, EmaLeigh Crawford. Aunts and uncles, Vickie Browning, Joan and Johnny Ballenger, Mary and Alon Hudson, Mary and Marvin Crawford, Anne and Ed Crawford, Eileen and Ron Mueller, Larry Cooke, Johnny Foster and a large number of cousins. Terri also leaves behind so many friends who touched her life beyond words.

Terri was currently employed at Upstate OB-GYN, having previously been Office Manager for J. David Smith, PA.

Terri was a graduate of Wren High School in Piedmont, SC.

She was an avid "Gamecock" fan, and didn't mind sharing that with all she

came in contact with.

She was a member of Wren Baptist Church where she taught 1st through 3rd Grade Sunday School Classes and worked with the Teens Loving Christ (TLC) Group who will serve as honorary escort. Terri loved her Lord, her church, and her church family. She was a very caring and giving person, always wanting to help others. So, even in death, she is helping others by donating her organs through Lifepoint.

Her presence, kindness and spunk will be sorely missed, but she left so many memories for us to hold on to.

Funeral services will be held 2:00 p.m. Wednesday, July 21, 2010 at The Wood Mortuary, conducted by Rev. Harold Sanders and Rev. Gene Neely. Burial will follow in Wood Memorial Park.
