Born in Morcone, Italy, she was the daughter of the late Giuseppe and Maria Candida Curcio Colesanti. She was the last surviving member of her family. She was a war bride and the first international to reside in Greer. She served lunches to thousands from Victor Elementary, East Greer to Greenville Middle and High Schools. Mrs. Lynn was a member of Greer First Baptist Church where she was a member of Baraca and Victory Sunday school class.

Surviving are her children, Jim Lynn of Easley, Maria Lynn, Richard Lynn both of Greer; a brother, Sigismondo Colesanti of Brooklyn, N.Y. and six grandchildren, Michael Chad Roddy, Dabny Lynn, Tristan Lynn, Erica Lynn, Derrick Lynn and Stephanie Lynn.
