Theron C. Farmer Jr., 77, of Greenville, SC died on March 14, 2018. He is the son of the late Odessa Griffin and Theron Clyde Farmer Sr., and is preceded in death by a sister Geraldine Guilliard Jones. He is the father of two sons, Derek and Christopher, from his marriage to Patricia Peele Farmer. His surviving sisters are Billie Grant of Walhalla, SC and Margie Aughtry of Gaffney, SC.
