February 4, 1939 - May 12, 2018

Theron Douglas "Doug" Wilson, 79, passed away on May 12, 2018.

A native of Greer, son of the late Golden Lee "Tom" and Margaret Jones Wilson, he was twice retired from Texize Dow Brands after 33 years of service and Canal Insurance after 11 years of service and a U.S. Air Force Veteran. Mr. Wilson was a dedicated member of Simpsonville United Methodist Church for 53 years.

Surviving are his wife, Gail E. Wilson of the home; two sons, Russell L. Wilson (Donna) of Greer and Jonathan D. Wilson (Stacey) of Greenville; one sister, Gayle W.
