Thomas (Tommy) Ray Fisher, 60, of 1508 Haven Bend, Tampa, Florida, died January 17, 2010 after a brief illness.

A native of Spartanburg County, son of John Ray Fisher of Tampa, Florida and Dorothy Taylor Adams of Greer, he was a U.S. Army Vietnam veteran. During his tour of Vietnam he was a member of the 101st Airborne Division having earned The Air Medal, Bronze Star, Army Commendation, and Purple Heart. Tommy was a former employee of Calvin-Boyd Machinery, a member of Victor Baptist Church, Greer, S.C., a member of the Bailey Masonic Lodge #146, and a Hejaz Shriner.
