“ Travis,

I miss you so much. The last time I sent you a letter, my life was going well. Dad was right--the world changed when you left us, and not for the better. Sometimes I'm almost glad you did not have to deal with things like the the climate crisis and quarantine--all of 2020, honestly. But you still deserved to live much longer than you did. You deserved to have a life that would continue to touch others, but more importantly, make YOU happy. No matter what the world was like, you'd always make it a better place and I know that.

I feel like a disappointment to you now and can't help but worry that the turn my life has taken would make you dislike me, but I should probably assume more of the better and less of the worst. I know, no matter how you would have thought of me now, that you loved me so much, and you always will.

*As I get older, memories of you fade. I don't remember your voice and hope I can find home videos soon to remedy that. But there are many that I still treasure. I still remember when you'd drive me home in that black Suzuki, you'd sing, it sounded like total s***. It made me giggle. I remember the last time we got to walk around granny's house with your best friend, and I took a picture of the two of you. I was so proud that I figured out how to get a good shot. I remember when mom had a heart attack because my favorite band was MCR, and you tried to show me Muse. For the record, it didn't work. I love MCR even to this day--but I do like Muse and absolutely weep when I hear Knights of Cydonia. I know that wasn't the intended effect. I'm sorry. But the memory itself still shines so bright in my head and my heart.*

When I tell dry jokes, I think of you. I ask mom often to share her memories, ask dad to tell me stories, so that we can keep bringing them to the forefront of our minds. As they get older, I still want them to retain as many of those memories as they can. And it scares me, watching them age, knowing that there are things I'll

have to deal with alone. Throughout my life, I have yearned for your wisdom and guidance. It certainly helped me when I was much younger.

One last thing: after your passing, I always felt like I had lost the only person who would ever understand me. The only person who knew my mind, who knew how I worked. But after 15(?) years of you being gone, I think I have found people who love me, care, and really do at least try to understand me. I think I am finally in good hands.

I asked mom and dad if we could get together for your birthday and celebrate, and they said yes. Our aunts might be coming and I'm so excited for it. 40 is a milestone, even if you're not here to see it.

I miss you, I think of you every day, I love you. And you were and always will be my hero, Travis. No matter how much older I become than you were the day you died. No matter how bad things get, how odd my life becomes, you will always be in my heart. I fight as hard as I do because of you.

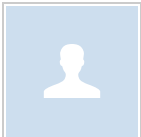

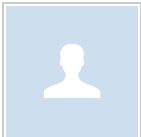

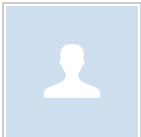
