June 27, 1929 - November 19, 2013

Velmah Alexander Price, 84, widow of D. C. Price and resident of Greer, S.C., since 1955, died on November 19, 2013, at her home. She was born June 27, 1929, in Charleston, S.C., to the late Mary Abbot and Calbraith Capers Alexander. In 1935 the family moved to Batesburg, S.C. She graduated from Batesburg-Leesville High School and Limestone College in Gaffney, S.C. She taught school for thirty-four years, thirty-two of which were in the Greer schools.
