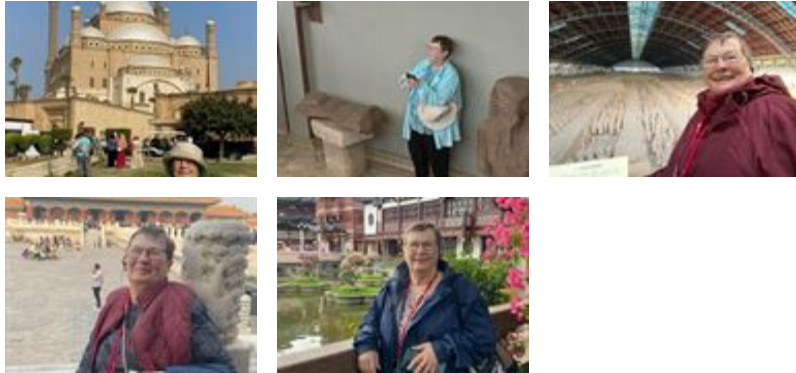
She loved world wide cuisines, introduced us to Indian and Thai food. Never a dull moment on a Tripp adventure.

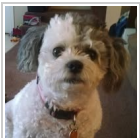

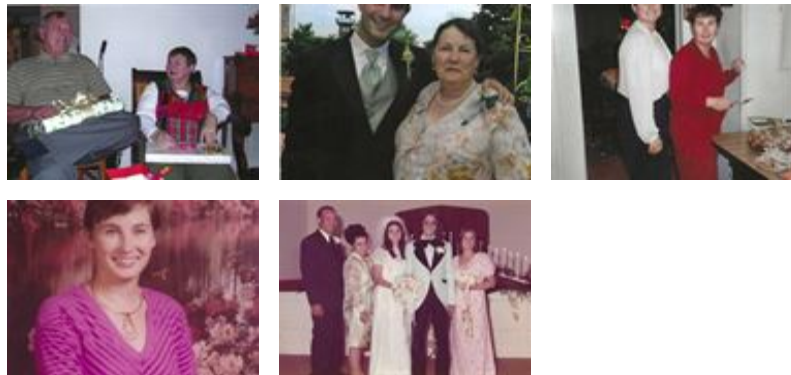
