William "Bill" Clifford Williams, 91, widower of Sharon Katherine Poyser Williams, passed away January 12, 2022.

A native of Blountstown, FL, son of the late Henry Clifford and Malzie Adel Pitts Williams, he was a United States Air Force Veteran, during the Korean War, retired from Monsanto and a member of Taylors First Baptist Church, where he served in many capacities including chairman of deacons, Sunday School teacher, and participated in various mission trips. He served as a volunteer for Meals on Wheels, and numerous missions and ministries including Concoxiions Ministries for which he was also on the board of directors.
