Mr. William M. Lindsay, of Navaho Drive passed away February 11, 2009 at the age of 78. He was born January 10, 1931 and was the son of Francis Eugene and Agnes Durham Lindsay.

Marshall was predeceased by his wife, his high school sweetheart, Virginia "Ginny" O'Neal Lindsay in 2007. They were married for 54 years.

He is survived by his sons, Christopher of Spartanburg and Michael of Mount Pleasant and his wife, Shannon and a grandchild, Hayden; mother Agnes Lindsay of Greer; a brother, Ted Lindsay of Greer; and two sisters, Bobbie Jo Hudson and Linda Sue Barnette both of Greer.

Mr. Lindsay was predeceased by a sister, Norma Jean Bennefield.

After completing Greer High School in 1950, he went to North Greenville College where he was a three sport star. He was quarterback and captain of North Greenville College first college football team in 1950. Mr. Lindsay played every game in the 1950-1951 seasons. He was co-captain of the basketball team for two years and played baseball. He continued in sports at Furman University where he graduated in 1955 with a B.S. in Biology.

Marshall worked with Pfizer Labs Inc. as a pharmaceutical sales representative from 1957-1996. He loved talking to the doctors and staff who knew him as "Pot".

He served on the Spartanburg City council from 1992 to 1996. Marshall was

active in the National Guard with Battery A, 1st Battalion, 178th Artillery, 30th Infantry Division as Captain and retired as Major.

He was inducted into the North Greenville College Athletic Hall of Fame in 2004 for his sports achievements.

Funeral services will be held 11:00 a.m. Friday at Wood Mortuary conducted by Rev. Billy E. Vaughn and Rev. Jerry Satterfield. Burial will follow at Wood Memorial Park.

Visitation will be held 9:30-11:00 a.m. Friday at Wood Mortuary.
