May 18, 1925 - September 28, 2011

William Thomas Turner, 86, of 9 Stevenson Road, widower of Elzora Ruby Stevenson Turner, died September 28, 2011 at his home.

A native of Spartanburg County, son of the late Josh Thomas and Helen Moore Turner, he was a U.S. Marine veteran of WWII, retired assistant manager for Greenville Memorial Auditorium and of the Baptist faith. He was Past Master of Taylors Masonic Lodge after 52 years, past Captain of Hejaz Provost Guard, a member of Scottish Rites Temple Hand, and a S.C. State Constable.

Surviving are two daughters, Barbara Duckett of the home and Marie Bailey of Travelers Rest; a brother, Ken Turner of Rock Hill, SC; a sister, Tennie Hudson of Pageland, SC; nine grandchildren and nineteen great-grandchildren.

Mr. Turner was predeceased by one son, Larry Thomas and one daughter, Linda Callicott.

Funeral services will be held 2:00 p.m. Saturday at The Wood Mortuary, conducted by Rev. Carol Caldwell. Burial will follow in Wood Memorial Park with military and Masonic rites.
